

Topic-based Talk Task: 5) Leaving school

1. Hand out the candidate's sheet.

2. Read out the instructions.

Your topic is 'leaving school'. Here are six boxes with different aspects.

You have to talk about three of them.

First you have 90 seconds to look at the boxes and to make notes if you wish.

Start when you are ready. Talk for about 2 minutes.

3. Wait 90 seconds. Then ask the candidate to start.

Please start now.

- 4. Let the candidate talk.
- 5. Ask one or two of the following questions ONLY if:
 - \rightarrow the candidate doesn't say anything,
 - \rightarrow you need to elicit more language.
- Do you have a plan for your life after school?
- Do you think you will miss school? Why?/Why not?
- What are you going to wear for graduation?
- What are your plans for graduation day?

6. Signal the end of this part of the examination after 2 minutes.
